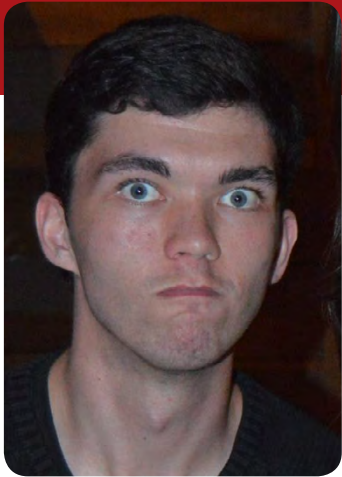
We stand at a crossroads. Order, or laughter; peace, or goofs; grace, or silliness. I come to you offering a utoikean society where no one will be

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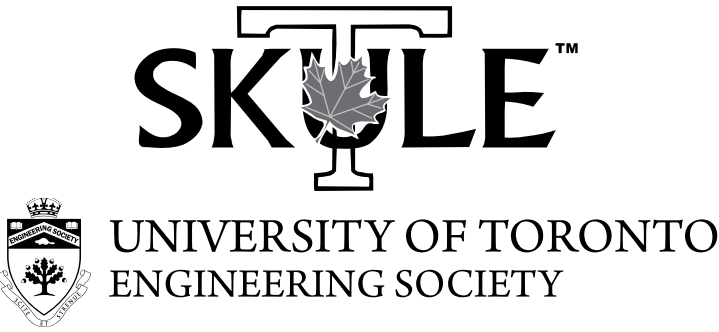

Chow To Add Bike Lanes to Bike Lanes

DAVID A. BALFOUR PARK - Olivia Chow attended a charity cycling event last Friday afternoon to promote her latest public transit plan. Donning full cycling gear, including a purple Lycra shirt and matching shorts, she appealed to cyclists and environmental activists by promising to add bike lanes to the city's existing bike lanes.

"There is a pressing need to improve sustainable transportation infrastructure in our city," says Chow. "The cycling community needs a solution that protects their safety and enhances their biking experience. Current bike lanes are full of dangerous cyclists and unpredictable situations."

"Adding bike lanes to our bike lanes will reduce the risk of serious injury, encouraging more people to choose biking as a mode of transportation."

Chow stated that the innovative solution, which would add 40 kilometers of bike lanes to existing bike lanes throughout the city, will catapult Toronto past cities like Portland and Copenhagen when it comes to forward-thinking cycling infrastructure.

The \$2 million plan follows the recommendations of a city-commissioned report on road transportation from 1990. One relevant excerpt from the report reads: "under the highly unlikely circumstances that

major thoroughfares such as the Gardiner Expressway and Highway 401 prove inadequate in relieving downtown congestion, more sustainable transportation will be required across the GTA."

"We have a great opportunity to enhance Toronto's image as a green city," said Chow. "And it's even sustainable, since as long as we are adding bike lanes we will always have more places to put the next ones. It's like Zeno's paradox, but with roadway maintenance."

Volunteers for Chow's

campaign were also spotted at the charity event, handing out various brochures and pins.

"I think she has a brilliant transit plan, and this bike lane component is the icing on the cake. She definitely has my vote for transit commissioner - oh, I mean mayor," said Jill Capriccio, an avid supporter of Olivia Chow.

Not everyone is in favour of Chow's plan, however. Rival candidate John Tory claims that she stole the idea from his plan to electrify the GO rail system.

"Adding bike lanes to bike lanes is, in principle, the same as putting a light rail system on train tracks."

An unconfirmed number of interns were spotted sobbing as they walked out of Tory's campaign office around noon on the day of the event, and several half-eaten tubs of ice cream were found later in an adjacent alley.

Doug Ford declined to comment when asked to compare Chow's proposal to his plan to add car lanes to bike lanes.

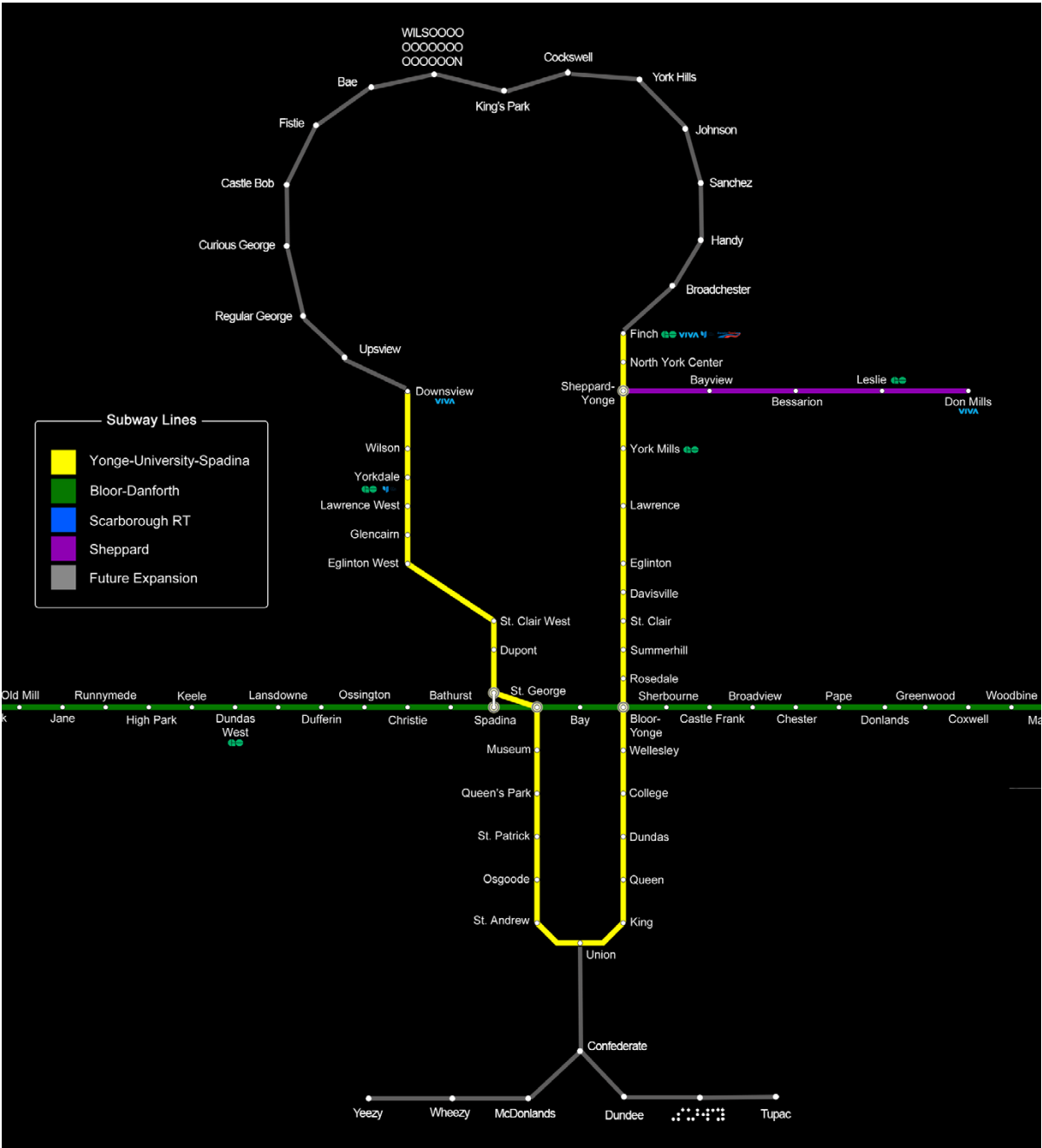
Despite the friction this motion has generated, some have found it very exciting.

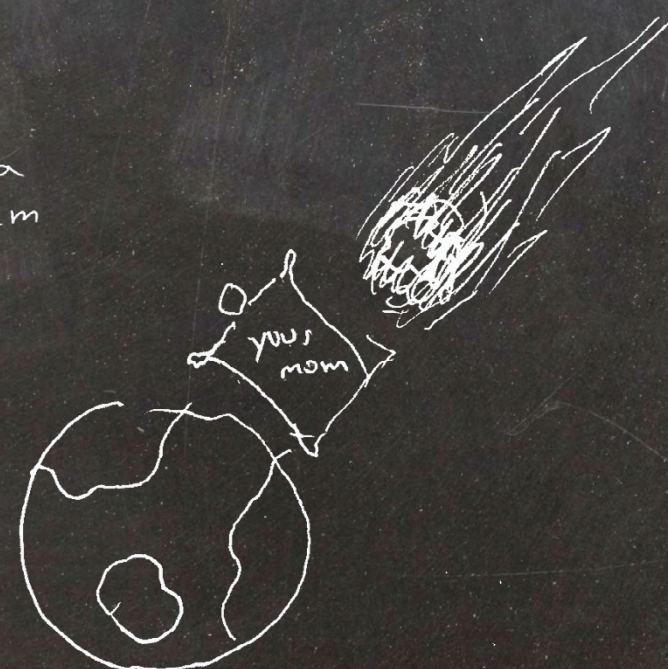

# UTSU Levee Ruptures

Last year, a critical UTSU levee came under criticism after the Annual General Meeting experienced a devastating flood of septic refuse. # U of T Accessibility Seating Moved to Ryerson

The University of Toronto has released plans to radically expand campus accessibility for limited-mobility students.

After a lengthy investigation by a task force of full-time investigators, it was decided that despite the campus basically being a lost cause, opportunities for improvement might lie elsewhere in the city. This new set of initiatives will completely eliminate the challenge of navigating campus that many students face, according to the administrators.

"We have fought with the notion of retrofitting many of our university's buildings for a long time," said investigator Art Vandelay. "We often get complaints that Sandford Fleming and Galbraith share a single wheelchair-accessible entrance, or that most of the campus is literally insulated with a carcinogen. However, if we tried to fix every little fire code violation we'd be in the poor house in no time."

Ryerson provided the perfect opportunity for further expansion for a number of reasons unearthed by the task force. Not only is it located south of the University of Toronto, making the trip easier on wheels, but it is already more academically accessible.

As a newer university, Ryerson has also had an easier time remaining financially solvent without giving the finger to impaired students.

The University of Toronto flirted with improved accessibility in 2002 with the construction of the Bahen Centre for Information Technology, which was widely considered a success.

With accommodations ranging from wheelchair-adjustable tables for improvement might lie elsewhere in the city. This new set of initiatives will completely eliminate the challenge of navigating campus that many students face, according to the administrators.

However, plans to complete the Bahen Centre's ceilings and hallway study benches have been indefinitely postponed due to a critical lack of funding and interest.

"If, for example, wheelchair-bound students aren't using these study spaces now, then why should the university make it possible for them to do so? There's just no market for it. Maybe if these kids were more committed to a quality education they'd get the results they're looking for."
